Resources to Help Your Child with School at Home



How can I translate online content from english to my preferred language?

On your computer, phone, or tablet, you can install Google Translate for free.
Once installed, it can be used without an Internet connection. Google Translate can be used to translate text, handwriting, speech, and websites.



What can I do if I'm having trouble understanding my child's schoolwork?

Reach out to your child's teacher or someone else at the school. Look for contact information from the school. Apply for special services if you think your child may need it.



How can I find meals for my child?

Visit <u>TXSchools.gov</u> to find nearby locations of schools offering freeschool meals (both breakfast and lunch for pick-up) while school buildings are closed. Select "Meal Pick-up Location" and enter an address to find the closest location.



How can I set up internet so my child can connect to his or her school?
