








TSDS KNOWN ISSUES TSDSKB-600 UPDATED ON 10/21

EARLY CHILDHOOD DATA SYSTEM (ECDS)

The ECDS submission is tentatively scheduled to open on Monday, October 28th. TEA stated that during Parallel that the assessment vendors had no issues sending data, but there were some issues with the SIS vendors. They would like districts to start working on ECDS as soon as they can, but they realize that right now the focus is on Fall PEIMS.




SSA/FISCAL AGENT REPORTING

1. LEAs who are members of a co-op or Shared Service Arrangement for **Special Education Services often have professional such as Speech** Therapists, Occupational Therapists, Educational Diagnosticians, etc. serve students on an irregular basis. For example, the co-op may have 6 different Speech Therapists. Any of those therapist may serve students at any of the member districts, so a member district might have up to 6 different therapists who come during the month of October and there may or may not be a therapist there on snapshot. Can you clarify the expectation regarding the reporting of those professionals for each member LEA? Would they report all Speech Therapists? Would they report only those who provided the services during the month of October? Will the member LEAs receive a Unique ID discrepancy since the therapists are listed in the TEA database as employed by the fiscal agent? If the fiscal agent pays the speech therapist, the fiscal agent will report the staff responsibility data for all the therapists and will use the School where the services are provided even though it will be a school outside of their LEA.




SSA/FISCAL AGENT REPORTING

2. We have had some pushback regarding disclosing personal data, from individuals who are employed by and receive their paychecks from another entity but provide services to schools. For example, a local hospital has been contracted to provide instructors for nursing classes. These are hospital employees, but since they provide professional services, we believe they should be reported as contracted professionals. The issue has been that these individuals often balk at providing their social security number, date of birth, legal name, etc... to entities other than their employer and certainly balk at providing that to multiple entities for reporting. Contracted staff would need to have Staff, StaffEducationOrganizationEmploymentAssociation, and either StaffSectionAssociation or StaffEducationOrganizationAssignmentAssociation reported if they are providing services as of the last Friday in October.



SSA/FISCAL AGENT REPORTING

3. Some ESC's provide contracted instruction to their districts. **Examples include Spanish by Distance Learning/computer,** services for visually impaired students, etc. These individuals are **ESC** employees and will be reported through the ESC PEIMS submission, but would they also be considered contracted instructional staff and need to be reported by each LEA in the Teaching and Learning Domain? That is our understanding, but I wanted to get clarification to ensure we provide the correct guidance. Is this arrangement provided through an SSA? If it is not provided through an SSA and the employees are just contracted instructional staff, the LEA would report the Staff, **StaffEducationOrganizationEmploymentAssociation and then** StaffSectionAssociation data.





IODS DELETES

As everyone should know there is no longer a Delete Utility in TSDS to assist in correcting data. The software vendors are responsible for providing a way for incorrect data to be deleted from the IODS. This usually can be accomplished by updating the incorrect data in the database and reextracting, but in some cases that does not work. Each record in JSON is assigned a Resource ID. If the LEA can give the vendor the Resource ID from JSON, the vendor should be able to delete the record.





The new export is scheduled to release on November 11, 2024. The "data dump" is from the IODS not promoted data in TSDS. The export is in CSV format.


It is suggested that when exporting to save two files in case you want to color code, sort, filter, hide columns, etc.

CENSUS BLOCK GROUP TOOL

There is currently an issue with downloading the Census Block Group Tool. Districts should download the tool from the Utilities option in TSDS and not update from inside current tool. After downloading and installing the version from the portal, you will open and launch the tool, it will prompt that an updated version is available. Proceed to download the updated version which will be Version 1.02702.
